A NEW INTERVENTION: STARTING THE FOUR YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMME (2023-24)

JVBI announces with pleasure that as the very first initiative, the Institute has adopted the new guidelines NEP 2020 for the Curriculum and Credit Framework for the Four Year Undergraduate Programmes, which has been released by the University Grants Commission. The Choice Based Credit system along with the curriculum and credit structure for the four-year UG programmes have been revised in light of the NEP 2020 recommendations.

Students will have various entry and exist points, variable degree options with single, double, multi, or trans-disciplinary choices, and a curriculum constructed with employability skills in addition to academic topics, as per the FYUP framework.

Highlights of the Four-year Undergraduate Programme

- UG degree programmes with three or four-year durations are available with a variety of entry and exit points as well as re-entry opportunities.
- After completing a one-year, two-semester course, students receive an undergraduate certificate, a two-year, four-semester certificate, and a threeyear, six-semester certificate, which is equivalent to a bachelor's degree.
- Candidates will be awarded a 4-year bachelor's degree (Honours with Research)
 after finishing an 8-semester programme if they also finish their major research
 project in their fourth year of study.
- The inclusion of credit-based programmes and assignments in value-based education, environmental education, and community service.
- The introduction of comprehensive and diverse undergraduate education will aid in the holistic development of human potential.
- The inclusion of choices to transition to other modes of learning, including offline, ODL, online, and hybrid modes of learning, is one of the new curricular framework's few features.
- Current college students, who are in their first or second year would also be offered the option to enrol in four-year undergraduate programmes.
- All students will have access to a four-year undergraduate degree, but they would not be forced to sign up for it.

ABOUT THE INSTITUTE

ESTABLISHMENT OF INSTITUTE:

Jain Vishva Bharati Institute (Deemed University) established in 1991 with the inspiration of 'Gurudev Tulsi'. This Institute is a solely an educational institution dedicated to cultivate and practice high ideas of 'Anekant' including tolerance and peaceful co-existence for the weal of the mankind. This Institution is registered under the Rajasthan Societies Registration Act 1958 vide Registration No. 43/ Nagaur/1991-92 dated 13.11.2007. Central Government vide Gazette Notification No. F-9-9/87-43 dated 20th March 1991 and F6-9/87CPP (Desk-C) dated 03.07.1991 issued by Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India approved this Institution as Deemed University under section 3 of the UGC Act 1956 and granted affiliation under section 12B of this Act. The Institution has been granted membership of Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi. The University has been accredited by **NAAC as grade 'A'**.

LADNUN - THE CITY:

Rajasthan is a magical land set amidst the desolate desert beauty. It's sand is replete with aeshetic beauty and chivalric glory and is immensely rich in culture, history and natural beauty. Everything about Rajasthan fascinates from miles of golden stretches of sand to the kaleidoscope of magnificent forts, opulent palaces and marvelous havelies, each having a splendid architectural creation and a legend of its own. The cities of Rajasthan still retain the medieval flavour keeping alive the timeless traditions in the rich art and craft.

Ladnun is well connected by road from Delhi, Jaipur, Jodhpur, Bikaner, Ajmer and Ahmedabad and by rail from Delhi, Ratangarh, Jodhpur, Didwana, Degana.

THE CAMPUS:

Even though the town is located in an arid zone, the campus is full of greenery with parks, peacocks and gardens. It is like an oasis in the middle of the desert. The environment is free from noise and pollution. The spiritual ambience of the campus provides a peaceful atmosphere of the traditional "Gurukul", and is ideal for studies and research. The academic environment on the campus fosters self-discipline, promotes quality of life and commitment to higher values.

STATE OF THE ART INFRASTRUCTURE

- **SMART CLASS ROOMS**: At present, the institutes has 20 smart class rooms where latest technology is being used for teaching.
- **CENTRAL LIBRARY:** There are over 75,000 books and more than 6000 rare manuscripts in Central Library, known as 'Vardhman Granthagar'. JVBI subscribes more than 150 Journals, 12000 e-journals and periodicals. The database in the library has been computerized and the students can search using the SOUL facility. Internet and Xerox facilities are also available for the students.
- **COMPUTER LABS:** State of Art Computer Laboratories with high-speed internet connectivity through RailTel is available. Students can make best use of these facilities to update themselves with the latest developments in their respective fields. All the departments have been connected through LAN.
- **LANGUAGE AND AUDIO VISUAL LAB**: JVBI has state of art Language Lab for developing English communication skills among students.
- **DIGITAL REPOSITORY**: More than eight hundred recorded video lectures have been uploaded.
- **DIGITAL STUDIO :** Digital Studio is equiped with the latest technology, where the renowned scholars record (Audio Visual) their lectures.
- **HOSTELS**: Separate 200 bedded hostels for girls with state of the art modern catering facility is available within the campus. Stay in the campus and hostels is very secure and safe. Accommodation is, however, limited and is provided on a first-cum-first-serve basis. Mess facility is also available in the hostels. Air Conditioned rooms are also available as per requirement.
- **MEDICAL CENTRE**: The Medical Consultancy services (Ayurvedic, Homeopathy, Naturopathy and Physiotherapy facility) are available on campus.
- **NATUROPATHY HOSPITAL**: A modern 50 Bed hospital with OPD facilities has been established on the Campus.
- **MEDITATION AND YOGA CENTRE:** Institute has the Centre for Yoga and Meditation with necessary equipments for development of balanced personality and healthy living.
- **AUDITORIUM**: The Institute has a well-equipped state of art auditorium to cater the need of academic and cultural programmes of the institute.
- **GYMNASIUM**: The Institute has gymnasium with all necessary equipments along with music system. This facility is available for staff and students separately for male and female.
- **SPORTS FACILITIES:** There are facilities of in-door and out-door games for the students and staff of the institute.
- **CANTEEN:** The well equiped hygenic canteen are situated in Campus.
- **GUEST HOUSE:** Institute has Guest House with matchless lodging and boarding facilities for the guests of Institute and parents of JVBI Students.
- **BANK:** Students can avail the Banking facilities of Punjab National Bank situated in the campus of Jain Vishva Bharati.
- **TRANSPORT FACILITIES:** Bus facility is available for the students who come from adjoining areas of Ladnun against the vehicle fee.

ALUMNI ASSOCIATION: Alumni association membership is open to all the present students of JVBI as well as those who have passed out and are working on different positions in many academic and corporate sectors. JVBI organizes alumni meet every year aiming at assisting the present students, in their final placement, training (block placement), field visits and providing them guidance about corporate world.

PLACEMENT CELL: The Institute accords due importance to the placement of its students. The Placement Cell is working at the Institute to establish network with prospective employers to ensure that the student get placed in good companies, commensuration with a background and experience. The placement record is commendable and lots of good companies have recruited our students in past.

MOUS/AGREEMENT: with Institutions and Industries in India and Abroad for student training and placements.

EARN WHILE YOU LEARN: Institute provides various creative skills to students under this scheme.

STUDY TOURS: Provision of regular Study Tours are there for the students which provide greater exposure to the students of both UG and PG level, thus enabling them to be acquainted with knowledge of their respective subjects and culture of the country.

STUDENT AND FACULTY EXCHANGE PROGRAMME: Memorandum of Understanding with several National and International Universities/Institutions have been signed by the institute to work in collaboration in the field of teaching, training and research.

COACHING SCHEMES FOR SC/ST/OBC AND MINORITIES: The main objective of the scheme is to prepare SC/ST/OBC (Non-creamy layer) minority communities and female candidates for appearing in NET or SLET and other competitive exams, so that sufficient number of candidates become available for selection as Asst. Professor in the College and University system.

CAREER AND COUNSELLING CELL: Along with the academic and administrative processes in JVBI, career and counselling cell supports the students in the development of soft skills and communication ability to challenge the rigors of competitive tests and on-job-training in add-on or vocational courses. As a purveyor of healthy intra and inter-personal relations, it inculcates social values, an ability to think out of box for carrying out social responsibilities. Eminent Scholars, personalities from govt. sector and industries are invited for academic excellence and job orientation throughout the year.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES: Institute provides short term training in Skill Development.

GUEST LECTURES: Lectures of guest speakers are organised frequently.

OMBUDSMAN: University has appointed an ombudsman, who conducts regular hearings and address the grienvences if any.

SUMMER PROGRAMMES: Institute conduct short term programmes during summer vacation.

INSURANCE: Group Insurance facility is available for the students.

STUDENTS FEEDBACK & EXIT MEET: At the end of every programme all the Departments organize an Exit Meet with the out-going students. A Feedback Performa is provided to each student to solicit their opinion in relation to the quality of teaching, teacher-student relationships, field work guidance, counselling, grievance redressal, student support system, infrastructure facilities etc.

NCC: National Cadet Corps is a tri-service organization comprising the Army, Navy and Air Force, engaged in grooming the youth – 'The Leaders of Tomorrow'. Jain Vishva Bharati Institute inaugurated NCC wing (Army) 3 Raj Girls Battalion on 24 Nov 2010. The motto of NCC is to develop Character, Comradeship,

Discipline, Leadership, Secular Outlook, Spirit of Adventure and Ideals of Selfless Service amongst the Youth of the Country. Institute has one unit of NCC (54 Cadets).

NSS: Institute has two units of National Service Scheme (NSS) (100 students each) with motto of 'Not Me But You', reflects the essence of democratic living and upholds the need for selfless service.

INTRODUCTION OF NEW EDUCATION POLICY:

From the session 2023-2024, JVBI has adopted New Education Policy, 2020 as per UGC guidelines for the purpose of Academic Bank of Credit Scheme. Course requirements, acceptance of interdisciplinary and multi-disciplinary course, credit transfer and acceptance of credit has been introduced. Multiple entry exit options will be available to the students.

ACADEMIC BANK OF CREDITS: ABC has been made functional 17,792 Degrees, 9,966 marksheets have been successfully uploaded.

STIPEND & SCHOLARSHIPS:

POST GRADUATE LEVEL: Department of Jainology and Comparative Religion and Philosophy, Prakrit and Sanskrit provide free hostel and Rs. 3000/- per month in lieu of meal facility. Department of Nonviolence and Peace provides need cum merit based scholarship (to be decided by the Vice Chancellor) for 10 months only, maximum for four students of each year.

POST GRADUATE LEVEL AND UNDER GRADUATE LEVEL: A limited number of merit-cum-need based scholarships are available for deserving students.

The students belonging to SC/ST/OBC are provided assistance and guidance to get scholarship from Social Welfare Dept. as per State Govt. norms. The students can also avail the scheme PG merit scholarship scheme for university under graduate 'Rank Holders' and other Scholarship under UGC Scheme as per UGC guidelines and pattern.

FEE EXEMPTION:

Fee exemption is available to the students who are economically weak but are meritorious as per the rules of the Institute.

Note: (i) 50% concession in Tuition fee in the Regular Programme and 50% concession in Programme Fee in the Distance Programme shall be granted to the spouse and two dependent children of the staff members of the JVBI. No concession will be given to staff member for his/her own study.

- (ii) 25% concession in Tuition fee in the Regular Programme and 25% concession in the Programme fee in the Distance Programme shall be granted to the spouse and two dependent children of the staff members of JVB.
- (iii) Sadhus/Sadhvis/Saman/Samanis/Mumukshu etc., who have renounced the worldly possessions are exempted from paying any kind of fee.
- (iv) In the event of a student/candidate found ineligible or withdrawing before the starting of the programme, the waiting list candidates should be given admission against the vacant seat. The entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of not more than Rs. 1000/- (one thousand only) shall be refunded to the student/candidate. In case a student leaves after joining the programme and the seat consequently falling vacant is filled by another candidate by the last date fixed for admission, the fee collected from the earlier candidate will be refunded accordingly.
- (v) The Institute reserves the right to revise the fees, etc., from time to time.

- (vi) In 12th percentage 91-100, Wave of 100% in Tution Fee.
- (vii) In 12th percentage 80-89, Wave of 50% in Tution Fee.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENT FOR RUNNING A PROGRAME:

The commencement of any regular programme or any subject is subject to the enrolment of a minimum number of students. If the admission in a particular programme/subject is less than 5 in PG programme and 10 in UG Programme/subject, the said programme/subject will not be continued except 2 in the programme of Prakrit and 5 in the case of Sanskrit. In Social Work and English (P.G.) minimum new admission should not be less than 15, otherwise admission in such programme can be put in abeyance. The decision of the competent authority will be final.

INTRODUCTION OF CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM AND CONTINUOUS ASSESSMENT OF STUDENTS:

From the session 2015-16 onwords the Choice Based Credit System has been introduced.

All students will be required as a condition of enrolment to agree and abide by and to submit to the procedures of the Institute's regulations as amended from time to time.

PROVIDING THE FACILITY OF MOOCs:

The Institute has made available the students the facility of MOOCs courses and has given options among many subjects taught through SWAYAM portal of Govt. of India. The credits earned through SWAYAM are included in Grade Card of a student leading to a degree as per the guidelines of Govt. of India.

INFORMATION REGARDING REGULAR PROGRAMME

PROCESS TO FILL THE APPLICATION FORM:

- Step- 1 Candidates seeking admission in the academic session 2024-2025 may download the Prospectus from the website https://jvbi.ac.in and read carefully for Programmes, fee and other details.
- Step 2 New Learner Registration form available on : https://online.jvbi.ac.in/register
- Step- 3 After Registration a user name and password received on registered email.
- Step 4 Login with email and password : https://online.jvbi.ac.in/Login
- Step 5 Filled Basic Information, Choose Programme and Course and upload required documents
 - (a) Photo: Use jpg/png/jpeg. File Size: 50KB to 1 MB
 - (b) Signature: Use jpg/png/jpeg. File Size: 50KB to 1 MB
 - (c) Documents: in pdf. File Size: 50KB to 1 MB
 - (i) 10th Marksheet (Secondary)
 - (ii) 12th Marksheet (Senior Secondary)
 - (ii) UG/PG Marksheet (Only for PG Learners)
 - (iii) Aadhar Card (Both Side)
 - (iv) Migration Certificate
 - (v) Transfer Certificate
 - (vi) Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) Account Number.

Note: Original Migration, Transfer Certificate, Minority, Caste Certificate deposit in concerned department.

Step - 6 After submit required fee, a final submit button displayed on screen.

The Application Fee once paid is non-refundable and no further correspondence in this regards will be entertained.

- Incomplete applications shall be summarily rejected.
- Candidates whose results have not been declared, may also apply for admission provided they produce
 the result/ certificate of the qualifying examination by the last date of admission as per the list in which the
 name of the student figures.
- The last dates for acceptance of application forms for each of the programme is shown in Academic Calendar.
- Those satisfying the eligibility requirements will have to face written test. Interview for all the programme will be conducted in Institute (Date provided in Academic Calendar)
- Attendance in a 3 days Personality Development Camp is mandatory to all the admitted students in Semester-I. Those who will not complete this programme their admission will automatically be cancelled.
- The list of the candidates selected for interview after passing written test shall be displayed in ascending order of their Entrance Test Roll No. on the Notice Board of the Faculty/ Department / Centre concerned as well as on the JVBI's website on the dates given in the admission schedule.
- In all programme admission will be made on the basis of academic merit along with the marks obtained in written test and performance at interview.

RULES REGARDING ADMISSION:

- All the selected candidates are required to submit Transfer Certificate/Migration Certificate in original at the time of admission on or before 15 October, 2024, if not submitted earlier along with admission form and with late fee of Rs. 250/- is 31.10.2024 and Rs. 500/- is 07.11.2024.
- If a candidate fails to complete the admission formalities by the prescribed date, he/she will automatically forfeit his/her right to admission.

- The Institute reserves the right to refuse admission in any individual case without assigning any reason.
- No candidate will be allowed to take up a full time job while pursuing a full time course. Those, who are
 employed at the time of admission, will be required to produce a certificate of leave from their employer
 within one month from the date of admission, failing which their admission will be automatically cancelled.
- A student of Semester-I of any course who is detained due to shortage of attendance will no longer remain the student of the Institute. Such students will have to seek fresh admission and will be required to go through the entire admission process.
- A student of other than Semester-I of any course who has not taken examinations due to shortage of attendance may be given re-admission in the same class of that course against payment of fee for that semester. In case, he/she fails to fulfill the requirement of attendance after being given re-admission he/she shall not be given another chance.
- Fresh admission to the new course will be granted to only those candidates whose results of the qualifying examinations are completed in all respect by the last date of admission as per the list in which the name of the student figures.

RESERVATION OF SEATS:

Reservation of Seats will be as per Norms of Rajasthan Government.

ATTENDANCE:

- Students shall be required to be regular in their classes and attend not less than 75% of the aggregate of lectures/ tutorials/ practical of all compulsory/ optional/ honours and subsidiary subjects in order to be eligible to appear in the annual/semester examinations. Any student having less than 75% attendance will not be allowed to appear in the written examination.
- Attendance of the students shall be counted from the date of admission in the respective programme.
- If a student is found to be continuously absent from the class without any information for a period of 7 days or more his/her name shall be struck off from the rolls.
- Request for relaxation in attendance on account of participation in the N.C.C., N.S.S., Institute Sports and other
 activities organized by the Institute must be sent to the Head of the Department/Principal within 15 days of
 the function/activity through respective incharge.
- However, shortfall of 5% attendance can be condoned by the Head of the Department /Principal on account of sickness provided by the student the sickness and fitness certificate from a Registered Medical Practitioner within seven days from recovery or on account of any other extenuating circumstances supported by documentary evidence. The conduct of the student will be highly recommended. Condonation upto another 5%, may be considered by the Vice Chancellor on account of any other circumstances provided that the request is duly supported by documentary evidence and strongly recommended by HOD/Principal concerned.

RE-ADMISSION:

- If a student remains absent for consecutively seven days without leave/permission, his/her name shall be struck off from the rolls by the Department concerned and it will be conveyed to the office of the competent authority on the same day or latest by the next day.
- Such a student may, however, apply to the Vice-Chancellor through Head of the Dept./Principal for readmission within 7 days from the date of issuance of notice of struck off the name.

• The re-admission shall be effected as per norms by paying Rs. 2500/- (Two thousand five hundred) as a fine. If the name of the student is struck off on any other ground the same fee of re-admission would be applicable to him/her also. In case of blank semester in core B.Ed./M.Ed./B.A.-B.Ed./B.Sc.-B.Ed., Readmission fee will be 50% of the total fee (as per government rules).

ADMISSION TO HOSTEL:

- The students, desirous to be admitted in the hostels, should contact Chief Warden of the Institute for admission formalities.
- Students willing to stay in Air-Conditioned Rooms in the hostel should apply to the Chief Warden and the same will be allotted provided after depositing requisite fee meant for Air-conditioned rooms. Air-condition rooms will be provided on 1st cum 1st basis as per availability of rooms in Yuva Lok building.
- Students admitted in hostel are required to pay prescribed full fee (from academic year) in advance. The
 hostel residents are required to follow hostel rules strictly.
- No hostel facility provided to Boys, part-time students and distance mode students.
- Hostel security will be refunded at the time of leaving the Institute on producing 'No dues certificates' from the sections concerned & original receipt of security paid.
- Information regarding hostel fee is given under the head of fee structure (Mentioned at page no. 58).
- All the hostellers are required to wear Identity card of the hostel issued by the Institute in the campus.
- Any violation of hostel bye laws by a hosteller will be liable to disciplinary action.
- Relatives/parents/guardians as mentioned in the admission form will only be allowed to meet the hostellers during day time.
- Relatives/parents/guardians are not allowed to stay in the hostel.

RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING CARE OF EQUIPMENTS:

- Equipments will be issued by the Store Incharge to the students on due authorization by the Head of the department concerned.
- Each student, to whom equipment has been issued, will have to sign a receipt.
- Any physical damage to equipments will be the direct responsibility of the students/group of students in whose name equipments are issued.
- Students returning the equipment after the due date will be charged late fee.
- Students must immediately inform the maintenance staff and teacher, of any faults they experience while handling the equipments.
- If a student loses or damages equipment issued to him or her, he or she should immediately inform the office through their Head of the department i.e. Stores/Faculty/ Administration giving full details of circumstances leading to the loss or damage of equipment.
- Student who has lost or damaged the equipment will be required to replace it within reasonable time, the identical piece(s) or part of the equipment or pay the current market value of the equipment.
- In case of damage or loss of any equipment by students working in a group, the fine will be levied collectively on the assigned group. At the time of admission an undertaking will also be taken from the student to this effect.

STUDENT'S DISCIPLINE:

- Every student should maintain the discipline of Institute.
- No student is allowed to visit places or areas declared by the competent authority as "Out of Bounds" for the students.
- Every student is required to carry his / her Identity Card issued by the competent authority. Every student, who has been issued the Identity Card shall have to produce or surrender the Identity Card, as and when required by the Proctorial Staff, Teaching and Library Staff and the Officials of the Institute.
- Any student found guilty of impersonation or of giving a false name or found guilty of forgery shall be liable to disciplinary action.
- The loss of the Identity Card, whenever it occurs, shall immediately be reported in writing to the Competent Authority. New Identity card will be provided after charging penalty of Rs. 100/-.

PROHIBITION AND PUNISHMENT FOR HARASSMENT AND RAGGING:

ANTI-RAGGING CELL: Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited within the premises of the Institute, in the premises of the Hostel or in rented quarters outside the campus and any part of JVBI system as well. **WHAT CONSTITUTES RAGGING**: The Institute has adopted UGC guidelines framed on the basis of Lyngdoh Committee. In the light of the guidelines, Ragging shall constitute one or more of any of the following acts:

- a) Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- b) Indulging in rowdy or indisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- c) Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- d) Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- e) Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- f) Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.
- g) Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- h) Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- i) Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.
- j) The student is required to submit online undertaking/affidavit in each academic year on website www.antiragging.in and www.amanmakement and forward e-mail received with his/her registration number and a weblink to the Nodal Officer of the Department/College. The list will be updated every 24 hours. Anti-Ragging undertaking reference no. is to be mentioned in the admission form.

ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION IN THE EVENT OF RAGGING: The institution shall punish a student found quilty of ragging after following the procedure and in the manner prescribed here in under:

- The Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution shall take an appropriate decision, in regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging established in the recommendations of the Anti-Ragging Squad.
- The Anti-Ragging Committee may, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely;
 - a) Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
 - b) Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
 - c) Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
 - d) Withholding result.
 - e) Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
 - f) Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
 - g) Cancellation of admission.
 - h) Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
 - Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.
- Provided that where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.
- An appeal against the order of punishment by the Anti-Ragging Committee shall be, (i) in case of an order of an institution, affiliated to or constituent part, of a University, to the Vice-Chancellor of the University; (ii) in case of an order of a University, to its Chancellor, (iii) in case of an institution of national importance created by an Act of Parliament, to the Chairman or Chancellor of the Institution, as the case may be.
- Where in the opinion of the appointing authority, a laps is attributable to any member of the faculty or staff of the institution, in the matter of reporting or taking prompt action to prevent an incident of ragging or who display an apathetic or insensitive attitude towards complaints of ragging, or who fail to take timely steps, whether required under these Regulations or otherwise, to prevent an incident or incidents of ragging, then such authority shall initiate departmental disciplinary action, in accordance with the prescribed procedure of the institution, against such member of the faculty or staff. Provided that where such lapse is attributable to the Head of the institution, the authority designated to appoint such Head shall take such departmental disciplinary action; and such action shall be without prejudice to any action that may be taken under the penal laws for abetment of ragging for failure to take timely steps in the prevention of ragging or punishing any student found guilty of ragging.

ANTI-SEXUAL HARRASMENT CELL:

As a part of the Policy against Sexual Harassment, JVBI seeks to maintain and create an academic and work environment, free of sexual harassment for students, academic and non-teaching staff. This will also apply to outsiders and residents, on the JVBI campus.

All complaints of ragging and sexual harassment would be heard and redressed by the Committee, framed for the purpose from time to time by the Vice-Chancellor of the Institute and in accordance with the rules framed for the purpose.

BREACH OF DISCIPLINE INCLUDES:

- Use of Non-vegetarian food items, Smoking, Tobacco, drugs and any intoxicants including alcohol and alcoholic product.
- Irregularity in attendance.
- Causing disturbance to classes, offices, libraries, auditoriums, play grounds etc.
- Misconduct or misbehaviour of any nature at the time of meetings, during curricular or extra-curricular activities of the Institute.
- Misconduct or misbehaviour of any nature at the examination centre.
- Misconduct or misbehaviour of any nature towards a teacher or any employee of the Institute or any visitor to the Institute.
- Causing damage to the property of the Institute.
- Giving publicity to misleading accounts or rumours amongst the students.
- Refusing to produce or surrender the Identity Card as and when required by competent authority and other staff of the Institute.
- Students found guilty of breach of discipline shall be liable to punishment, as fine, campus ban, expulsion or rustication.
- All powers relating to discipline and disciplinary action in relation to student vest in Vice-Chancellor.
 However, the Vice-Chancellor may delegate all or any of his/her powers as he/she deems proper to
 the other competent authority.

AWARD OF DEGREE

- Students who successfully complete the programmes of study will be awarded degrees at the Convocation. If convocation is not organized then degrees will be distributed from the counter after its approval by the concern statutory body.
- The Examination Results of each semester will be displayed on the website of Institute http:// www.jvbi.ac.in. The detailed grade card of each Semester will also be displayed on website, consolidated detail marks card after completion of programme will be issued instead of Semesterwise. The students can download the detail of marks for re-evaluation purpose etc.

A student can pursue two full time academic programmes in physical mode, provided that in such cases, class timings for one programme do not overlap with the class timings of the other programme. Similarly, a student can pursue two academic programmes, one in full time physical mode and another in Open and Distance Learning (ODL)/Online mode; or up to two ODL/Online programmes simultaneously.
